Category

- The entry to the race is open to runners of all ages. Children under the age of six are eligible to participate in the Fun Run activity, provided that they are accompanied by a parent or legal guardian throughout the duration of the run and remain under their direct supervision at all times.
- Each runner has to ensure that his/her health condition is sufficient for the event.
- Each runner is responsible for having sufficient insurance coverage. AmazingKids may offer additional insurance at its sole discretion.
- Entries are not refundable, transferrable or deferrable. No runner shall be entitled to an entry fee refund in case of disqualification.



RUN COURSE

The entire run course is situated within Wellington College International School and is completely traffic-controlled.

The Fun Run course includes one or more laps around the stadium's running track and football field.

Distance	: 1.5 km	(1 lap)
Distance	: 3 km	(2 laps)

Run Aid Station

There is 1 aid station on the 1 km run lap, and/or the distance between aid stations passages is a maximum of 2.5 km.





The Race

Signs and Symbols for the Running Race Route

Athletes must follow the route indicated by the directional signs, which will be installed along the entire running path, and must strictly adhere to the instructions at all times.

There will be a team and officials on the course to supervise and provide guidance to athletes at all times during the competition. Please follow their instructions and all race regulations.

Finish Line

All finishers will be rewarded with a special medal from the event organizers.

The top 20 finishers in each race category will receive a commemorative lion doll at the finish line, and spectators are welcome to congratulate them at the finish point.

Importants:

Friends, family members, supporters, private photographers (non-official) and/or other spectators are not permitted to cross the finish line or enter the finish chute with participating athletes.



EVENT AWARDS

All athletes who cross the finish line, regardless of whether they complete the 1.5-kilometer or 3-kilometer distance, will receive a commemorative medal for participating in the AMAZINGKIDS fun run event.

Additionally, the top 20 finishers in each distance category will receive a commemorative doll at the finish line.



In the interest of promoting family participation in sports, the fun run event will not feature timed races or trophy awards, unless otherwise specified for individual events. Please consult the Athlete Guide for each specific event for further details.

POINTS COLLECTION SYSTEM

By participating in the AmazingKids fun run event, point will not be accumulated to an athlete's overall point standing and not eligibility for the Series Championship and Multi-Sport Championship awards.



COMPETITION RULES

GENERAL BEHAVIOR

1. Participants must follow instructions as given from all event officials including race directors, course marshals, medical personnel, and fire & police officials, throughout the duration of the event.

2. All participants are expected to conduct themselves in a professional and courteous manner towards the community and their fellow participants during their participation in the event. This means, for example, no alcohol consumption, urinating or defecating in public except in designated toilet facilities, participant obstruction anywhere on or near the course shall be strictly prohibited.

3. The use of music devices (e.g. iPods), cell phones, cameras or similar devices by participants while in the event is strongly not allow at our event to enjoy all that our event has to offer and for the safety of all participants. Volunteers will be providing directions to help you to the finish line. The event officials reserve the right to disqualify any participant using such devices on the course.

4. For the safety and enjoyment of all event participants, the courses are restricted to registered runners/walkers, Wheelchair participants must obtain written permission of the Race Director at least 7 days prior to the event.

5. The use of wheeled devices by participants or any other person authorized to be on the course shall be strictly limited to (a) wheelchair participants, (b) authorized course officials, and (c) authorized course marshals on bicycles. Skateboards, rollerblades, unauthorized bicycles or any other wheeled device will not be permitted on the course.

6. Baby joggers and strollers are permitted to use on the Run course. However, participants who chose to use baby joggers and/or strollers in the race are asked to start towards the back of the pack at the start line, need to yield to faster runners and cannot impede other runners' progress. The event officials reserve the right to disqualify any participant using such devices who poses a safety hazard on the course. It is the responsibility of the participant to determine the suitability of the course - including kerbs, raised medians, road crossings and gravel surfaces - for the particular device they intend to use within the race.

**COMPETITION RULES**

7. Participants must begin the event during the official recognized starting times. The course will remain secured until the Official End vehicle crosses the finish line. At that time, the event is officially concluded, there will be no traffic protection and course Aid Stations will cease operations.

8. In order to avoid congestion, please try not to stop in front of a water station. Take your cup and keep moving forward or move to the side. Allow runners behind you to get their water.

9. Please keep the line chute area clear by continuing to jog or walk after crossing the finish line; wait for friends after the chute area.

10. Medical personnel authorized by the event may examine any participant who appears in distress. If, in the sole opinion of authorized medical personnel, it is in the best interest of the participant's health and welfare, medical personnel may remove a participant from the event.

11. Participants must retire at once from the race if ordered to do so by a member of the event staff, medical staff, or any governmental authority, including fire and police officers.

12. Event officials reserve the right to delay, cancel or suspend the race due to factors in accordance with Emergency Protocol on severe emergencies and/or weather.

13. Participants are responsible for the recognition and understanding of event signage, symbols, maps facilities and directions.

14. Spectators are asked to remain off the course and/or in designated spectator areas during the events.





Athlete Waiver

Every athlete and their respective parents or guardians are required to sign the athlete waiver form. The signed waiver form must be presented at the Race Pack Collection point.

RACE PACK COLLECTION PROCESS

The race pack collection process will proceed as outlined below:

1. Present signed the waiver form.
2. Check athlete and parents/guardians' ID cards.
3. Pick up race pack.

All athletes are required to check-in and collect their race packs from 04:30=05:00 AM and no later than 04.30 am on Sunday, 1 June 2025. Please note that check-in and race pack collection will not be possible after this time.

RACE PACK ITEMS

During the registration process, you will receive your race pack, which will include the following items:

- BIB Number
- Athlete shirt for 3 km.

If your BIB number is not displayed correctly, it could result in disqualification from the competition. Please fill in your medical details on the front of your race number so that volunteers and medical staff can access this information if necessary. Ensure you have your medical details ready before entering the field on race day.

Both the athlete and their parents/guardians must collect the race pack together during the athlete check-in process. Please note that it is not permissible for anyone else to compete using your name, nor for you to participate under someone else's name.

Additionally, please take into account that competing under a different athlete's name, bib number, or registration information will result in a suspension from future AmazingKids races. This policy is in place to ensure your safety, as in case of an emergency, we have on record the medical and emergency contact details of registered athlete only.



THE RACE

Starting Point

- All participants are responsible for knowing the race's start time and check-in method. All participants must be present at the appointed time to receive instructions and to participate in the Official Start of the race.
- Participants shall assemble at the event for the race no less than 15 minutes prior to the race start.
- Athletes will enter the running field, with the 3-kilometer race starting first, followed by the 1.5-kilometer race.
There will be a 5-minute interval between the start of each race distance.

Finish Line

- (a) The finish line will be located in the main sports field.
- (b) Reaching the finish line is considered complete when the athlete's chest or shoulder touches the finish line tape.



ATHLETE GARDEN

The Athlete Garden in the Expo Arena offers the following amenities:

- Food and beverage services
- Changing facilities
- Toilets

The showers are available in the swimming pool area.

Feel free to spend as much time as you like in the AmazingKids Village. Relax, enjoy the refreshments, and make room for other athletes who have completed the race and are making their way to the village.

AWARDS CEREMONY

The awards ceremony will take place at the football field near the finish line. The award will be awarded to the top 20 finishers of each race distance. The top 20 athletes will receive a special limited lion doll. ***Prizes will not be mailed; winning athletes are requested to collect their prizes at the finish line.***

TIMING RESULTS

Race timing will not be implemented for this fun run event.

LOST & FOUND

AmazingKids will not be held responsible for lost belongings. Any items found and collected by race officials in various zones or along the course will be turned in and retrieved at the Lost & Found counter near registration area on race day.

All lost and found items may not be immediately available for collection immediately after you finish the race. We appreciate your patience.

Unclaimed items will be held by AmazingKids for 45 days after the race day. Athletes can retrieve them by covering the shipping costs and an administration fee. Any items left unclaimed after the deadline will be discarded.
